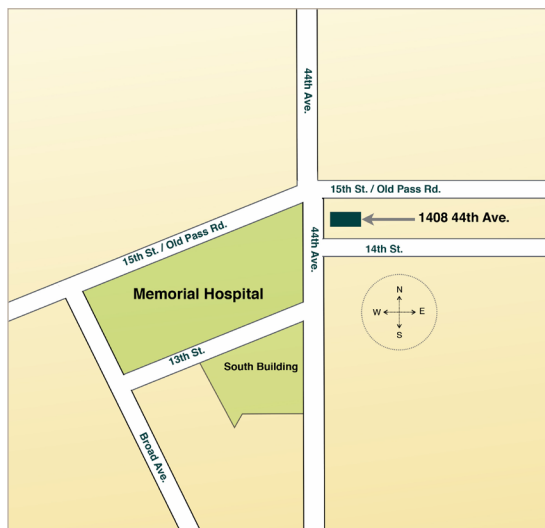

The main focus is to prevent diseases and promote wellness among workers.

Occupational health physicians must:

- » have knowledge of potential hazards in the workplace including toxic properties of materials used
- » evaluate employee fitness for work
- » diagnose and treat occupational disease and injury
- » know about rehabilitation methods, health education, and government laws and regulations concerning workplace health
- » manage health service delivery
